



• Bayhawk Ales, Irving, CA — EGL purple and EGL clear gold tubing

• Nor'Wester Brewing Co., Portland, OR — EGL clear red, Technolux super blue and EGL clear gold tubing

 Aviator Ales, Seattle, WA — (middle left) EGL clear gold, Technolux super blue and Voltarc neo ruby tubing; (bottom) Voltarc neo ruby, EGL clear gold and Technolux super blue tubing

• Pyramid Ales, Kalama, WA, and Seattle, WA — EGL clear red and EGL clear gold tubing

• Hale's Ales, Kirkland, WA — EGL 6500 white, Voltarc neo blue and Noviol gold coated tubing
